

We are currently working in partnership with Halton Borough Council to develop a School Travel Plan (STP)

A STP sets out how we will assist pupils, parents and staff to remove barriers to walking and cycling by making the journey to school safer, to promote healthy and sustainable travel and to reduce car dependency.

The school uses advice and assistance from the local authority STP Officer to produce its STP document. The plan would include such elements as:

- A description of the school's location;
- A summary of its transport and road safety problems;
- Proposed initiatives; and
- Proposals for on-going monitoring and review of the plan

STPs work by looking in detail at children's needs on their school journey. Parents, governors, teachers and pupils then work together to find effective travel solutions that will address local issues.

We are asking all parents to document any concerns, issues or suggestions you may have regarding your child's journey to school. It doesn't matter how your child travels whether it be on foot or by car, a travel plan aims to support all parents with their travel choices.
